The importance of Boonruang forest

1. It is an important aquaculture area of the Mekong River.
2. It is a natural water retention area (Kaem Ling).
3. Sources diversity of plant species, animals breed, plant genetics, and herbs.
4. Sources of wildlife habitat and seasonal migration.
5. Carbon pool and carbon sink
6. Food Security and source of salary of villagers.
7. Learning and research sources.

The relationship between Boonruang Forest and the villagers is not less than 300 years of commitment. From

only using the forest for living into customary which leads to the learning of descendants that transfer knowledge from generation to generation.

Boonruang Forest also helps to capture and become carbon storage called “Carbon pool and carbon sink” which it makes clear atmosphere, reduce pollution and turns to be fresh air for people and the community.



Nong Pla O is a pond in the middle of forest, when there is flooding in rainy seasons. It is an area of reproduction of aquatic animals not just that but it is a habitat of migratory birds. The pond give both people and animals benefits.



Wetland with local vegetation relate animal species in the area which is a diverse area of plant species, animal breed, wildlife animals from Doi Luang, Doi Luang, animals from the Mekong River, and seasonal migratory birds.
